HERITAGE IN ROMANIAN INDUSTRIAL HEMP

• TRADITION:

- Before 1989, Romania was **NUMBER 4 GLOBAL HEMP EXPORTER**, WITH **OVER 55,000** cultivated hectares
- LOCAL VARIETIES SINCE 70', CURRENTLY 11 registered in the EU plant catalogue;
- SCALABLE LAND FOR HEMP today less than 2000 hectares, BUT easily scalable.

RESEARCH has been getting on:

- 2 strong research units in hemp cultivation— Lovrin in West and Secuieni in North East of Romania— currently keeping on efforts in farming and tehnologies research;
- 1 research institut in agri-equipments;
- 1 research unit in traditional, household practices and models Textile Museum;
- UNIVERSITIES joining efforts in research for innovation, hemp based products and technologies Arad, lasi;
